### **Parking**

I would like to thank the parents/carers who are walking or cycling to and from school, either from home or from the Village Hall, and to those who are parking considerately both outside the school and on the school playground. We ask that all parents/carers who do park outside the school do so in such a way that it does not cause an obstruction for pedestrians or other road users. We would also like to remind parents that park on the school playground of the following rules:

1. Switch off engines whilst parked. Please do not turn your engine back on until the gates are opened (at approximately 3.45pm).
2. Do not reverse.
3. Park diagonally, facing the exit.
4. Drive on and off the playground at no more than 5mph.
5. On exiting the playground, pedestrians have the right of way. Please be mindful of this.

If a family friend or member of the extended family is collecting your child, please ensure that they are also aware of the above.
