### Our Immediate Priorities

By the end of July 2024, we aim to ensure that we:	
<b>1a</b>	Develop a shared understanding of learner progress and what it looks like over time.
<b>1b</b>	Establish a robust system to monitor pupil progress against expected/predicted outcomes.
<b>2</b>	Raise standards of Oracy and Welsh across the school and develop the implementation and delivery of an international language (French) to all learners.
<b>3</b>	Further develop systems that allow the Governors to fulfil the ‘challenge’ element of their role.
<b>4?</b>	Work alongside the Pembroke Cluster of Schools to develop a Social Action Project, where pupils from each school make a positive difference to others or the environment.
<b>Pupil Voice</b>	To work alongside staff, parents/carers and the Governing Body to develop a dynamic Homework Policy to support the delivery of the Curriculum for Wales (C4W).
