### ***Christmas Concerts***

We will be holding the Christmas Concerts for Barafundle up to Skrinkle on the week commencing 11<sup>th</sup> December 2023. The classes will be performing as follows:

Each family has been allocated a maximum of three tickets for their children's performance. Request lists are available in the school foyer from tomorrow (Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> November) until Thursday of next week (30<sup>th</sup> November). Requests for additional tickets may be made (a list will be available for this), however these cannot be guaranteed. If you have any seating requirements, such as disabled access, please speak to the School Office.

The tickets will cost £2.50 each and will be available from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December. Please send the correct money to school in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name and class, and we will send the tickets home with your child. All money raised will be used to subsidise the school visit to the Pantomime.

Year 6 will be holding their 'Nine Lessons and Nine Carols' on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> December at Lamphey Church, commencing at 6pm. Tickets will not be required for this service however we may ask for numbers attending closer to the time. There will be a collection during the performance, where you may make a donation towards the church.

### ***Beauty and the Beast***

Children from Swan Lake (Reception) to Amroth (Year 6) will be visiting the Torch Theatre on the morning of Friday 1<sup>st</sup> December to watch 'Beauty and the Beast'. We will be leaving school at 9.15am promptly therefore all children must be in school by 8.45am. School uniform must be worn. Children will be able to order a hot meal to take home as there will be only one early pick up time on this day (1.15pm). Homework club will still be running for the afternoon.

Children may bring a small packet of sweets (e.g. Haribo, starburst etc) and squash in their bottle but we ask that no chocolate, crisps, fizzy drinks or glass bottles be brought in by any children. This visit will be subsidised by the Friends of Lamphey Primary School and by the money raised by the Christmas Concerts.
